SUBJECT: PROPOSED STUDY ON THE "PLYING SAUGERS" PREMOMENA; INTELLIGENCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Pursuant to instructions, Surervisor M.W. Kuhrtz of the Lisison Section attended the Intelligence Advisory Committee (IAC) meeting on December 4, 1952.

None of the igends items are of direct interest to the Bureau; however, directed the members' attention to some aspects of the "flying saucers" phenomena. He said that a recent pre-entation of a theory on "saucers" was made by a Germin atimic scientist, which fact his cased the British to initiate considerable intelligence affort into this mitter. According to the afforts are being made to obtain the German scientist's paper on this theory. Also, it was stated that a recent "saucers" observation in office presents some evidence that the "saucers" are not a meteorological phenomena, which theory has been held to date by the Air Force. Instead, this latter incident indicated the possibility of the "saucers" being a scientific development. The details of this African observation were not presented; however, appropriate contact will be made by the Bureau's Licisan Bartion with the Air Force to determine the details of this latter perort.

As a result of the above, the Military rombers suggested a logical approach which would call for a group of scientists to make a study of the new "saucers" data in an effort to identify the phenomena. If an identification can be rade by the scientists and it can be determined that the "saucars" are a scientific development, then IAC should determine a further course of action for the U.S. Government. It was further suggested that the IAC should only concern itself with this matter the basis that a competent scientific group right determine the "saucers" to be a accentific development under the control of our enemy.
